
The kind where you regenerate a lock file and a bunch of your own business logic bugs decide to show themselves.

Oh no. Yeah this is one reason I try not to blow away the lockfile. I try pretty hard to make only small targeted updates. We really can have better tools for this than we do today.





Dependency Selector Syntax (DSS)

<https://docs.vlt.sh/packages/query>

- Answer complex, multi-faceted questions about dependencies, their relationships & associative metadata
- Consolidates redundant logic of similar, legacy list commands
- CSS Selectors 4 Spec (syntax & operators)



Dependency Selector Syntax (DSS)

<code>*</code>	- all deps
<code>:root > *</code>	- all direct deps
<code>:root > .prod</code>	- direct production deps
<code>:root > .dev</code>	- direct development deps
<code>:root > * > .peer</code>	- any peer dep of a direct deps
<code>.workspace</code>	- any workspace dep
<code>.workspace > .workspace</code>	- all workspaces that depend on another workspace
<code>.workspace:has(*.peer)</code>	- all workspaces that have peer deps
<code>[name=@vltpkg/query]</code>	- any deps named "@vltpkg/query"
<code>#lodash</code>	- any dep named "lodash"
<code>#lodash[version~=1.2]</code>	- any deps named "lodash" & version beginning with "1.2"
<code>*:empty</code>	- deps with no other deps (ie. "leaf" nodes)
<code>*:has(*)</code>	- has any deps
<code>*:not(:empty)</code>	- "" - equivalent to the above
<code>*:type(git)</code>	- querying for all git dependencies



// find all dependencies that have a node.engines property set
*:attr(engines,[node])

// find all dependencies that have defined react as an optional peer
*:has(#react):not(:attr(peerDependenciesMeta, react, [optional]))

// find all dependencies that have myself as a contributor
*:attr(contributors, [email=luke@lukekarrys.com])


// find all references to "install" scripts
*[scripts=install],
*[scripts=postinstall],
*[scripts=preinstall]




